“POLAR FLEECE THROW”



Embroider and add a little decorative serging and an ordinary piece of polar fleece can become an extraordinary gift.

Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies:

Baby Lock Ellageo

6 ¼” x 10 ¼” hoop

Baby Lock Christmas III Disk Pack (BLDP-Christmas3)

Baby Lock Imagine Serger

1 2/3 yards polar fleece

2 spools decorative serger thread such as YLI Pearl Crown Rayon or Woolly Nylon

1 to 2 Cones Maxi-Lock Thread

Assorted Embroidery threads

Water solvable stabilizer

Machine embroidery spray adhesive



Instructions:

1. Cut the four corners of the polar fleece fabric so you have rounded edges.
2. Hoop water solvable stabilizer in the hoop and lightly spray with embroidery spray adhesive.
3. Position one corner of the polar fleece on the hoop so the remaining fleece is facing the hoop bracket and will be to the left of the machine.
4. Cut another piece of stabilizer and lightly mist with spray adhesive, position on top of the polar fleece covering the area to be embroidered.
5. Select the design and rotate it in the hoop, so the top of the carolers face left and the bottom of the sign faces the corner of the fleece.
6. Embroider the design using assorted colors of embroidery thread to compliment your fleece.
7. Set your serger up with your favorite decorative stitch and decorative threads. Try a three-thread wide or blanket stitch; refer to your owner's manual, threading reference chart, or machine workbook for help.
8. Serge the edge of the polar fleece to add a decorative thread finish.
